

6D5N Beijing – Tianjin Muslim Ski Tour in/out Tianjin

Day 1 KL – Tianjin - Beijing (D)

Arrive in **Tianjin** in the afternoon. Transfer to Beijing by private coach. Check into hotel for rest & refreshment after lunch. Dinner. Enjoy the wonderful **Acrobatic Show** at night

Day 2 Beijing (B/L/D)

Our program starts with the tour to **Tian An Men Square** -- the largest city square in the world, bordered by the Great Hall of the People and Chairman Mao's Mausoleum. Then head to the **Forbidden City**, the complex of imperial palace, which was home to the Emperors for over 500 years. Grand halls and courts gradually give way to more intimate domestic quarters, giving an insight into the pampered isolation of the emperors. After lunch, **Dzohor & Asar prayers** will be held at **Niujie Mosque** -- the oldest Mosque with over one thousand year's history. Stop by at **Chinese Traditional Medicine Center** (also called **Herbal Medicine Center**) for a nice **Foot Massage** & enjoy the tea ceremony at the **Tea House**. After dining at the most famous **Xin Jiang Muslim Restaurant** for dinner, go back to hotel.

Day 3 Beijing (B/L/D)

Today is the highlight of our China tour, the climbing of the **Great Wall of China**. First built in the Warring States period (475-221BC) as a series of earthworks erected by individual kingdoms as a defense against each other as well as from invasions from the north, the wall we see in the present day wall was left from the Ming dynasty. Lunch at a local Muslim restaurant nearby. Shopping at the **Jade and Crystal Shop**. Then visit the **Burning Cream Centre**. Check into nearby Rose Valley Ski Resort – **3 star Days Inn Hotel** (or similar class) at night.

Day 4 Ski at Rose Valley Resort (B/L/D)

We will ski at **Rose Valley Ski Resort** in the morning. Please note that our price includes entrance fee for skiing. There is an additional charge for skiing and renting skiing equipments which is on your own. Head to downtown after lunch. Our first destination this afternoon is **Summer Palace**. Being the largest imperial garden in China, the Summer Palace was first built in the Qing emperor Qianlong's time in 1751 and burned down in 1860 by the French and British army and restored by the Dowager empress Cixi for her own enjoyment. It became a favorite haunt of Cixi, who preferred it to the Forbidden City, and named it Yihe Yuan meaning the garden of health and harmony. Then pray at the Ming dynasty-built **Nan Dou Ya Mosque** who is famous for the unique Chinese style & hundreds years of history. We will spend some afternoon time at the **Silk Store**, where very fine silk products will be presented. **Fresh Water Pearl Center**, as the best place to buy pearls, is also included in our Beijing trip.

Day 5 Beijing (B/L/D)

Today we will first have an outside tour to **Olympic Stadiums** – the prestigious **Bird's Nest & Water Cube** and do some shopping at nearby **Olympic Sponsor Jewelry City**. Stop by at **Muslim Super Market** – the only supermarket for Muslims in Beijing. The rest of the day is devoted to bazaars– **Sunny Gold Street** is the first place to go. The evening time will be spent at **Wang Fu Jing Shopping Street** and its **Night Food Market**, where you will see a collection of Halal snacks.

Day 6 Beijing - Tianjin - Home (B/L)

Take private coach to Tianjin in the morning. **Tianjin**, a city of 130 kilometers southeast of Beijing, serving as the gateway of Bohai Sea, means Port to Heavenly Capital. People started to settle in Tianjin in the Song Dynasty (960-1279A.D) By the 15th century it had become a garrison town enclosed by walls. After several decades of development, now it's one of China's leading manufacturing and commercial centers. There we will visit the famous **Food Street** and **Culture**
